

## **WESTCHESTER COUNTY DPW&T TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT**

The Westchester County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) assures that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, sex, age, disability or national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (P.L. 100.259) be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity. DPW&T further assures every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, whether those programs and activities are federally funded or not. In the event that DPW&T distributes federal aid funds to another entity, DPW&T will include Title VI language in all written agreements and will monitor for compliance.
