

## LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Westchester County Department of Public Works & Transportation has filed a grant application pursuant to Section 5307, the Urbanized Area Formula Funding Program.

Grant Funding Being Sought:

1. Grant funding amount is \$560,000 (Fed - 5307 - Urbanized Area Formula Grants)
2. Grant funding amount is \$140,000 (Local Match)

Total Funding Amount: \$700,000.00

A. Program of Projects will include the projects listed below that will require up to the following:

- Westchester County SMART Commute Program  
The SMART Commute Program enables the County to promote measures to help reduce traffic congestion and vehicle greenhouse gas emissions by encouraging the use of public transportation and other alternatives modes other than single-occupancy vehicles
- Promote the use of MetroCard as Bee-Line's fare medium through public outreach and prepare for the OMNY fare collection system
- Continue to work with MTA-NYCTA on the mobile MetroCard van sales program
- Promote the Reduced Fare program to seniors and people with disabilities
- Promote online trip planning features through 511NY trip planner and Google Transit
- Target of Travel Demand Management (TDM) services to educational, health, community, and Senior Services groups and establishments located in the County under the banner of Green Commuting, Be Educated About Transit, and the Transportation Collaborative for volunteer drivers for seniors
- Marketing and promotion of County employees' participation in the ridesharing program under the 511NY Rideshare program
- On-site and virtual "Transportation Fairs" that will provide commuters with detailed information about sustainable transportation options

This program of projects will become the final program unless a revised program is published.

B. Federal Allocation Information

Urbanized Area: New York and Northern New Jersey.

Designated Recipient: Westchester County.

Grantee: Westchester County Department of Transportation.

Grant Number: 1803-2025-4

C. Relocation: No persons, families or businesses will be displaced by these projects.

D. Environment: None of the projects described above will have any adverse environmental effects.

- E. Comprehensive Planning: This project is in conformance with comprehensive land use and transportation planning in Westchester County.
- F. Elderly and Disabled: The elderly and disabled will be among those County residents who benefit from improved transportation services as a result of these projects.
